MASTERS LDR FUTURE 2015 CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- Plans to hold the USATF 10K championships as part of the Longmont Turkey Trot fell through in late-October, in part due to the amount of time needed in order to successfully include USATF.
- LDR still requires a 5K; 10K – 10-Mile; or 20K – Marathon for 2015.
 - Based on loss of the men's and women's LDR earlier this year, the rapidly approaching end of 2015, and extremely limited number of potential (certified and/or reputable) venues, I recommend that we move forward and look ahead to 2016. Rather than attempting to coordinate a last-minute event that increases the chances that problems will be encountered, I propose that the LDRs formulate a plan to successfully meet all required championships for 2016. This will allow sufficient preparation across Colorado Association LDR Chairs and Officers to coordinate events well ahead of anticipated race dates to help ensure successful events that are mutually beneficial to USATF and Race Directors.

OTHER NOTES.

- Kathy coordinated with Flatirons Running Events to host the USATF Colorado Association State XC Championships as part of the Colorado Club XC Championships. The event will be held in Boulder on November 21. I will be racing and will also manage the USATF awards portion of the race.
