- road races must be conducted on a USATF certified course
- place the championship logo that is provided by USATF Colorado on:
the race website with a link to the championship page on the USATF Colorado website;
on the event shirts.
- include a box/field in the registration portal that asks the entrant for their USATF Colorado membership number and work with USATF Colorado to verify the entry list to ensure USATF Colorado members are identified in the event database.
- allow USATF Colorado signage to be hung at the finish area of the event
- allow USATF Colorado to setup a tent on race day and distribute USATF membership marketing materials
